

## Creative Project for *Watership Down*

Creative projects are used to find new ways of thinking about literature. You have explored many ideas, themes, characters, and plot twists in reading and studying this book, and this is a way to let your own ideas and thoughts about this book really shine through. You should plan to spend at least 5-6 hours on this project. You may pick from one of the following choices:

1. You can make a **carefully** constructed collage with written explanations of each image reflecting your impressions of the book *Watership Down*. You must include at least 10 images. In a separate paper, explain each image and why you chose it. Images cannot be printed, they must come from magazines, photos, etc.
2. A 4-page, 12 font, doubled spaced short story similar to the style of *Watership Down* (using animals as the main characters, going on a journey, nature, etc.) **or** a short sequel to the story using the characters in the novel. What happens next to the band of rabbits?
3. An alphabet book for *Watership Down*. You should include characters, concepts, themes, symbols, etc and illustrate each letter with a picture.
4. A **detailed** illustration, sculpture, painting or drawing of your favorite scene from *Watership Down*. Include a separate paper (at least 1.5 pages, double spaced) about why this scene was so touching, or was your favorite.
5. A project of your choice (**requires teacher approval**).
